And then just I went to my room and fell asleep. I can just say I had one of those days.


One day, I had the worst day ever. In the morning, I woke up and got into a fight with my brother over who should go to the bathroom first.



Later on, I missed the bus because I had a trouble putting my shoes on. I missed one hour of school. For my second period, I got questioned Geography and got a negative grade.




Then for lunch, I accidentally spilled my drink and had to clean up.


When my mom got home, she yelled at me and made me clean the house again. Later at night, I finally had a break and I was so glad. 😊



Qinling Panda

The Qinling panda was discovered in the 1960s. Qinling panda is a subspecies of the giant panda. Qinling pandas are found in the Qinling mountains in China. They are extremely rare and have a low population.



Qinling panda's fur is brown and white. The Qinling pandas are herbivores, which means they feed on plants only. They weigh 70 to 110 kilograms. They are 1.2m to 1.8m long and 60 to 90 centimetres tall. Their scientific name is *Ailuropoda melanoleuca qinlingensis*. A Qinling panda lives between 15 and 20 years in the wild. There are only 200 to 300 Qinling pandas living in the wild. The species is endangered and I really hope these beautiful pandas will not become extinct. A baby Qinling panda is called a cub. Qinling pandas are cute and beautiful animals.

Pufferfish

Pufferfish are rare species of fish hard to find because they live deep in the ocean (33 – 600 ft deep). Pufferfish can inflate into a ball shape by sucking water into their mouth and then pumping it into their stomach to avoid getting devoured by their predators. The scientific Pufferfish name is Tetraodontidae.



Almost every pufferfish contains a substance named tetrodotoxin, which is deadly to humans and 1,200 times more toxic than cyanide. One pufferfish can kill up to 30 adults and there is no known antidote. The liver of a pufferfish, also known as fugu, is considered a delicacy in Japan, but it's risky to eat because of the poison, which can cause paralysis and even death if ingested.

Pufferfish have four teeth, two at the top and two at the bottom, both fused to look like one large tooth, which makes them seem like they have a beak. They use their teeth for opening mussels, clams and shellfish, their teeth also never stop growing.

Striped hearts: I don't find them that often, because they are rare. They are white and very beautiful.




Scallops: I have found around ten scallops so far. They are rare too.


There is another kind of shellfish that are very rare, but I was lucky and found some. They are pink.

I also love to go fishing. I have all the equipment I need: a fishing rod, a fishing reel, a fishing line, hooks and weights.




I also need a sharp knife to clean the fish I catch. How do I do that?




You have to turn the fish belly up and then cut from the anus to the end of a belly bellow the gills. Then you remove all the internal parts and wash with a strong stream of water.

I usually catch a sea bass, a sea spider and a sea bream.



Sea spiders are really poisonous, their venom can cause serious injuries and sometimes even death. But they are also delicious if you know how to prepare them. You can eat them boiled, fried or grilled.



When we come from the seaside, I spend most of my free time in the forest. There are a lot of animals that I like there: deer, foxes, rabbits, wolves...

In autumn I like walking on dry leaves and building shelters from tree branches that I chop off myself with an axe.



In winter, the forest is covered in snow and everything is frozen. It is not easy for animals to find food. So I help them and set up a deer feeder where I leave them bread, carrots, apples and hay. I also take care of birds with a bird feeder.

Endangered species in Slovenia

Every day, many living animals and plants become extinct. It is happening in Slovenia too, so it is very important to do something about it and prevent it. A lot of animals are endangered, mostly because of their habitat destruction or

poaching.



Common (Eurasian) lynx

A lynx (*lynx lynx*) is a medium sized wild cat living in Northern and Central Europe and Asia. It grows up to 130 cm and can weigh up to 40 kilos. It lives about 12 years. Lynxes feed on deer, wild boars and other animals, they are carnivores. In Slovenia, biologists are trying to keep their population and they brought some lynxes from other countries.

Wolf (*canis lupus*) is a large canine which can be found in Dinaric mountains. It grows up to 1.8 metres in length and weighs between 23 and 50 kilos. Wolves live in groups called packs, but there are lone wolves, too. They are becoming extinct because of their habitat loss.



Striped grass snake (*elaphe*

quatorlineata) is the largest snake in Slovenia. It is about 2 metres long. You can recognise it by its four stripes. They feed on rodents and smaller birds.

We also try to protect bears, beavers and a European grey lizard and many other animals and plants. It is very important to take care of our planet and stop destroying the environment.

Madagascar Day Gecko



The Madagascar day gecko (*Phelsuma madagascariensis* *madagascariensis*) is a diurnal species of gecko – diurnal means it is active during the day. It lives on the eastern coast of Madagascar and typically inhabits rainforests. It dwells on trees.

This lizard is one of the largest living day lizards. It can reach a length of 22 cm. It has bright green scales which helps it camouflage among tropical leaves when they are waiting for their prey. It has red spots on its back. Males are generally more colourful than females. These geckos can live up to 15 years.

Geckos are the only lizards that can produce more than a simple sound. Their vocalization range from squeaks to barks and croaks. Giant day geckos mainly feed on arthropods (crabs, insects, spiders, scorpions). Occasionally, they eat sweet fruits and honey. They get water from condensation that forms on leaves.

In the picture above, you can see a Madagascanian gecko that I made from a modelling mass for an art competition. I named it »An endangered species of Madagascar«.

Human Fish

A human fish, also known as an olm or proteus is an aquatic salamander living in caves of Dinaric Alps. It is completely aquatic – it eats, sleeps and breeds in the water. Its scientific name is *proteus anguinus*. It feeds on microscopic animals called protozoans, larvae and



algae.

The olm's body is about 20 – 30 cm long. Females grow larger than males. It can survive without food up to ten years and can live up to sixty years or even a hundred. It lives in waters ranging from 5 to 15 degrees Celsius. The human fish needs clean water, it is vulnerable to water pollution. Therefore, the major threats to human fish are pollution and habitat disturbance from land, which includes all harmful changes of the environment above the caves they live in. Olms hunt their prey in the absolute dark and have developed excellent sensory system of smell, taste, hearing and electro sensitivity. They are sightless – their eyes as their body are covered by pale skin, sensitive to light. It has four short legs with three fingers on the front pair and two on the back, a tail and red gills.

Proteus anguinus is an endemic species to Dinaric Alps. There is also a completely black variant of the species.

Horses

The horse (*Equus ferus caballus*) is a big animal, sometimes wild, sometimes kept like a pet for riding. Horses weigh around 1000 kg and can live up to 25 years long. People found a way to gain trust from horses. Humans have always thought that horses are on this planet just to make travelling from one place to the other easier. In the past, horses



were used to move stuff from around 100 kg to around few tones 3000 kg. They didn't really mean anything to people so they often killed them and ate them. We eat horse meat and burgers even now, in 2022. The difference between wild and farm horses is that wild horses are bigger and free, while farm horses are smaller and don't have as much space as the wild ones.

Even nowadays, when we are more aware of animals' rights, there are still

a lot of cases where animal abuse is proven. In the USA there is a strong community trying to protects horses.

I think we all know a pony and a stable horse, but do you know any other breeds?

There is a horse breed on almost every letter in the alphabet. My favourite is an American paint horse. I also like *Auxois* because it has furry legs. *Pintabian* looks like that someone was clumsy and accidentally poured paint on them. *Trait du Nord* - huge and has a lot of muscles.

Wurttemberger – from Germany, primary riding horses, selectively for dressage and show jumping.

Yakutian (Yakut) – from Siberian Sakha Republic, it's pretty large next to other horses and has furry body and long mane (which is special – its mane grows for about 1 cm or 2 cm per two months).

Zemaitukas – a war horse, used in world war II.

The movie shows how the band got together, their arguments, tremendous fame and frontman Freddie's relationships with other people and his solo career.

When Freddie was in his 20s, he was known as Farrokh Bulsara. His family of a Persian descent lived in India and emigrated to Zanzibar, where Freddie was born. He studied graphic art and music in England and achieved worldwide fame as a frontman of the Queen due to his



artistic talent and spectacular voice. The movie shows how the band came up with the names of some albums and how they got their songs on the radio and television.

At one point of his career Freddie went solo after apologising to the band.

He struggled with aids for years keeping it a secret, but before he died, he made his diagnosis public.

The Queen played at the Live Aid concert, a unique rock concert in 1985, which was organised by Bob Geldof, another famous rock star, to raise charity funds. It was an absolute success. It raised 127 million \$ to help


relief famine in Africa, especially Ethiopia.

Parkour has its roots in military training and martial arts. It includes many sport

Parkour as a type of movement was established by a Frenchman called David Belle when he and other fellow parkourers founded the well known Yamakasi group of *l'art du déplacement* practitioners. Parkour has been massively popularized from the 90s through films, video games and ads.

The word parkour originates from *parcours du combattant*, which was a classic military training method. A practitioner of parkour is called a *traceur/traceuse*.

World Free running and Parkour Federation was established in 2007 due to MTV parkour related shows. International Gymnastics Federation added parkour as one of their disciplines in 2017.

The first parkour Tournament in Hiroshima was planned for the year 2020, but it got postponed to 2022 World Games.
